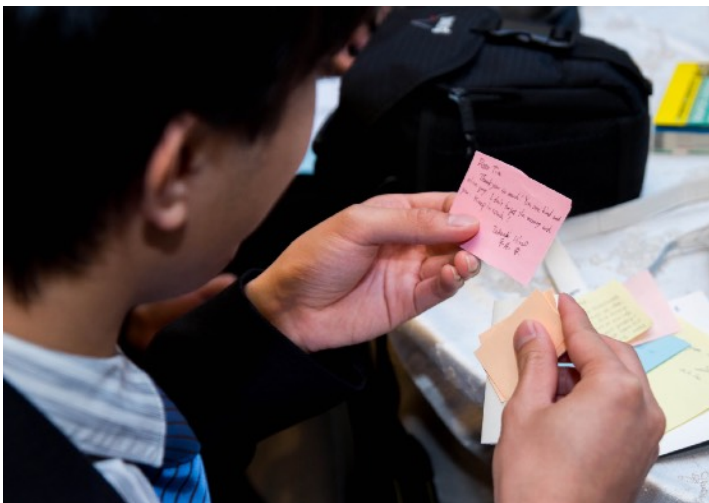

Fees Description

Registration Fee : SGD 80 per person

Program Fee : SGD 880 per person

It includes:
